In 1972, a young Kentucky doctor named Phil Curd, fresh from a term of service in the Peace Corps, was determined to find a way to use his medical training to serve the Kentuckians most in need of health care. So, Dr. Curd hung his shingle in a small white frame house that eventually gave the White House Clinics their name.
